They included my uncle, 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt. Gordon Phillips, USA, 83<sup>rd</sup> infantry division, who was part of the Normandy invasion and later killed in action during the battle for Saint-Lô. My cousin, 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt. James Scott, Jr., USA, 548<sup>th</sup> Bomb Squadron, was also killed in action flying his seventeenth B-17 mission over Germany. The Memorial honors the character and sacrifices of those who served for our country and changed the course of world history. It is a debt that can never be fully repaid.”

Dr. London added, “CACI takes great pride in our service to America’s military men and women. We are dedicated to providing the information solutions and services our military needs to meet today’s challenges.
